ABOUT THE POSITION:

Work at this level will influence design and the technical basis of the project. Responsibilities include but are not limited to, taking a leading role in the design phase with the Managing Director. Close coordination with the client and consultant team and understanding and complying with the applicable codes. Senior Associates are expected to undertake research in new technologies, materials and building systems. Senior Associates are expected to mentor Associates to ensure continuity on process and projects. A Senior Associate reports to the Director in charge of a specific project and the Managing Director and can range in experience and skill from an Architect II to Senior Project Manager in standard AIA skills definitions.

Primary responsibilities will include:

- Proficiency in the software needed for Jahn to execute work, including but not limited to Revit, Rhino, Enscape, AutoCAD, Photoshop, InDesign, and Bluebeam for example.
- Work directly with a Managing Director on concept designs and project development initiatives for diverse typologies.
- Report directly to a Director in the preparation of Schematic Design, Design Development, and Contract Documents.
- Project site visits, including the preparation of punch lists for completed parts of a project when appropriate.
- Undertake research for materials, new assemblies, and building systems.
- Analyzing a project's program and planning requirements.
- Taking a leading role in the design phase with the Managing Director, when appropriate.
- Providing a code and zoning analysis.
- Develop document registers alongside the project's Director.
- Is the primary point of contact with the engineering and consultant team.
- Providing drawing and technical reviews with the project's Director.
- Conduct interoffice and consultant coordination.
- Undertakes post-design project filing.
- On track to obtaining a license to practice in Illinois or another approved jurisdiction.
